## **ANIMAL LIFESAVING PERCENTAGE**

Our lifesaving percentage represents the number of animals being saved by our organization. Within the animal sheltering field, there are several different ways to calculate this number. Below are the three most popular methods.

Best Friends Save Rate = (Total Intake - Died or Lost in Care - Euthanasia excluding Owner Requested Euthanasia) / Total Intake - Owner Requested Euthanasia)	99.2%	
Maddie's Fund Live Release Rate = Live Outcomes / (All Outcomes - Untreatable Owner Requested Euthanasia - Died or Lost in Care)	99.7%	
ASILOMAR Live Release Rate = Live Outcomes / (All Outcomes - Untreatable Owner Requested Euthanasia)	99.2%
